DISTRICT BOARD OF REVISION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

The Town ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) and  
The Village of \_\_\_\_\_ and  
The Resort Village of \_\_\_\_\_ and  
The Resort Village of \_\_\_\_\_

(herein after referred to in the aggregate as the "municipalities".

WHEREAS the "municipalities" have passed resolutions requesting to participate in the formation of a District Board of Revision.

THEREFORE the municipalities agree as follows:

1. Five members shall be appointed to the District Board of Revision. The five members to be composed of at least one representative from each municipality.
2. No more than three members shall sit on the Board of Revision at any one time. Three members of the Board of Revision shall constitute a quorum.
3. The Administrator of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in consultation with the administrators of the municipalities, shall co-ordinate information between the councils of the municipalities.
4. The municipalities shall pass complimentary resolutions approving the appointment of a secretary to the District Board of Revision and amount of remuneration to be paid for his/her services.
5. The municipalities shall pass complimentary resolutions approving the appointments to the District Board of Revision and amount of remuneration to be paid for their services.
6. Elected or appointed officials of the municipalities included in this agreement shall not sit on the District Board of Revision or act as secretary to the District Board of Revision.
7. In the event of any dispute between the municipalities regarding appointments or remuneration, the matter shall be determined by a majority of the participating municipalities.
8. The Town of \_\_\_\_\_ shall pay for all expenses related to the operation of the District Board of Revision including the training of its members, and recover the costs from the participating municipalities in an amount proportional to the time spent by the District Board of Revision in hearing the appeals of the respective municipalities.
9. No municipality shall pay less than \$150.00 (One Hundred and Fifty Dollars) as its share of the cost for the operation of the District Board of Revision. This recognizes the cost of training and recruiting members for the Board. Recommendations for appointments for the District Board of Revision will come from the participating municipalities.
10. Any municipality may withdraw from this agreement by providing written notice prior to the 15th day of January of any year. Such notice of withdrawal shall be delivered to the Administrator

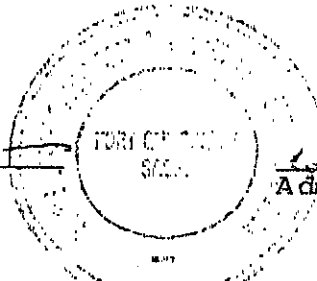
