The communities in the Northeast region of Saskatchewan between Tobin and Codette Lakes, first met in December of 2008 with the intention to build sustainability through intermunicipal cooperation. In 2009, after discussions on governance, structures and area for cooperation facilitated by MCDP, the Twin Lakes Community Planning Association was formed.

Twin Lakes Community Planning Association (TLCPA) is a proactive, diverse, multicultural collective of united communities that strives to understand and cooperate in planning and implementing a sustainable framework to enhance the future for the long-term betterment of region. Members of the Association consist of seven municipalities including:

- Town of Nipawin
- Town of Choiceland
- RM of Nipawin
- RM of Torch River
- Village of White Fox
- Village of Codette
- Resort Village of Tobin Lake

With the assistance of MCDP, TLCPA created and adopted a Memorandum of Understanding in October 2009 and developed a Community Action Plan which focuses on the following goals:

- 1) *Maintain and expand existing shared community services and identify opportunities for others*
- 2) *Undertake land use planning and uniform standards to support transportation and economic development and provide a foundation for service agreements*

Member municipalities continue to meet on the 4th Thursday of every month to discuss regional interests and integrated planning and development, and work toward the implementation of their action plan.
